





Portfolio Developments

In the first month of the year, RCII has operated in a tough environment with the Bucharest Stock Exchange's EUR-denominated index losing 25.6% whilst the Bulgarian index was down 20.6% in EUR terms. Taking these into account, RC II's NAV per share recorded a fall of 8.27% over the month. The structure of the Fund's equity portfolio, both Trading and Private Equity, broken down by sector, is presented below.



Romanian and Bulgarian Capital Market

The Bucharest Stock Exchange's EUR-denominated index (BET-EUR) was down 25.6% in January, with the market's total capitalization dropping from EUR 24.6bn at end-December 2007 to EUR 18.8bn. The Bulgarian Stock Exchange's SOFIX index lost 20.6% over the month, with the market seeing a 16.2% decrease in its total capitalization from EUR 14.8bn to EUR 12.4bn.

Romania's industrial production increased by 5.4% year-on-year in 2007, also triggered by a 6.4% year-on-year increase in the manufacturing sector. In 2007, construction works in Romania experienced a strong 33.6% year-on-year increase. Bulgaria's industrial production increased by 8.5% over the same period.
